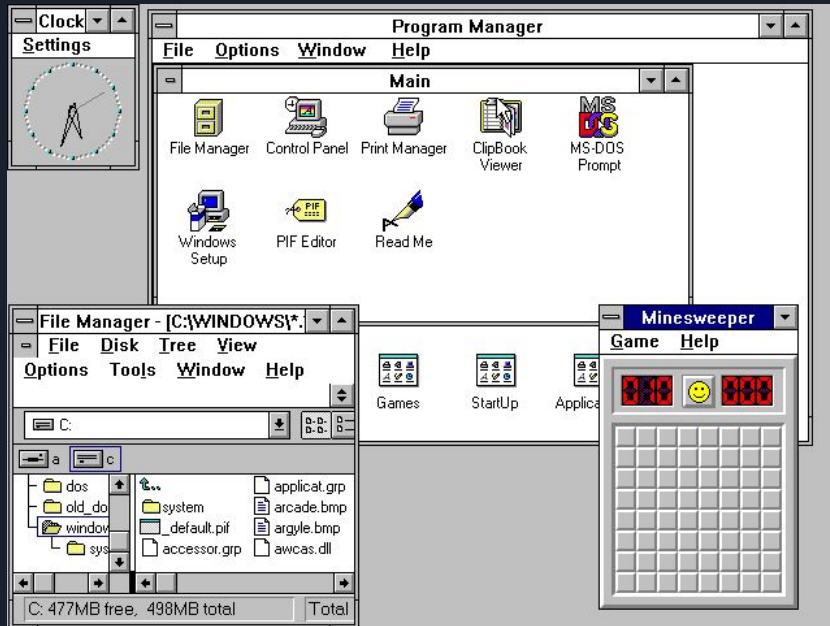

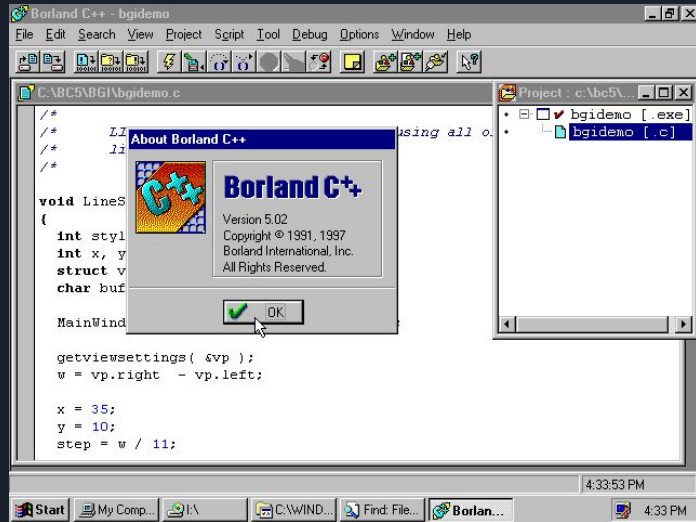
1995 - 2000: Pre-Linux Technology



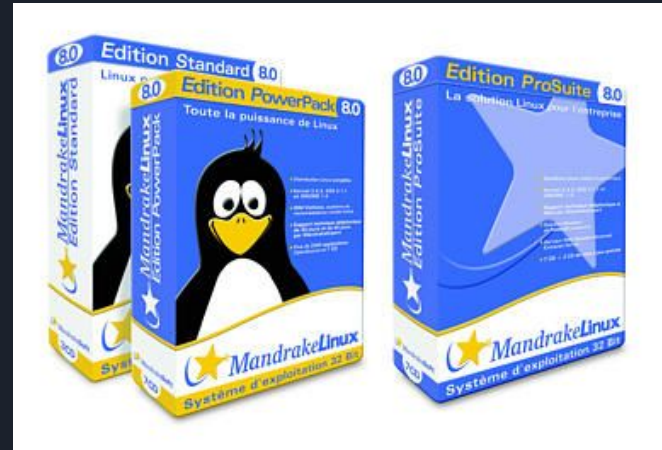
- DOS, Windows 3.11 and Windows 95.

- Using Red Hat 5 and 6 in college.

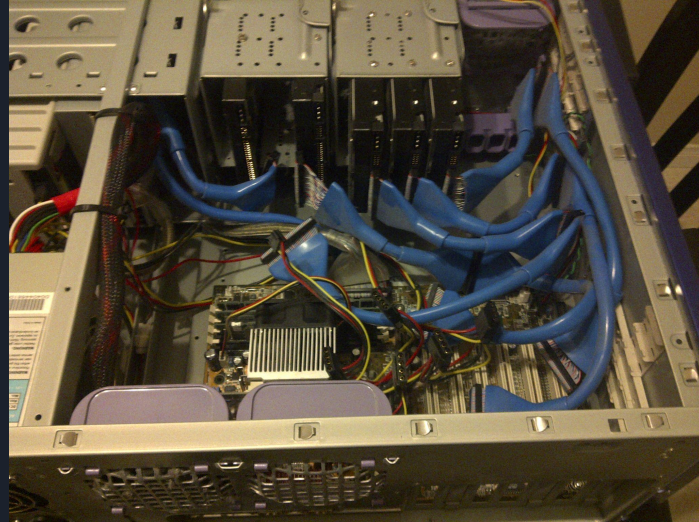
2002-2004: Building a homelab



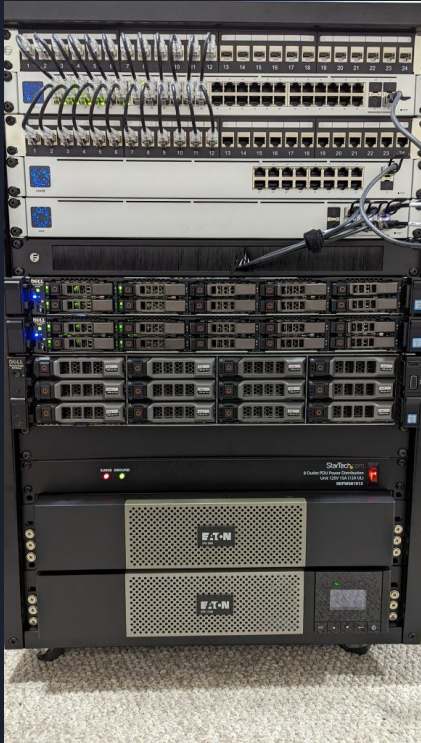
2004: Moved to Waterloo - RIM



- Moved to Waterloo, started at Research In Motion (BlackBerry) in May 2004 in Desktop Support.
- Built NAS using Pentium III running Gentoo with 4x160GB drives in software RAID-5 (480GB capacity).

- Homelab with Dell PowerEdge servers running VMware ESXi
 - Looking to switch to Proxmox or OpenStack.

- NAS running TrueNAS SCALE on Dell PowerEdge R730XD.

- Running FreePBX in a virtual machine to support house phones.
